PURPOSE:

1. Ongoing Macroenvironment Standards

- Š Fluorescent lighting is provided on a 12-hour on/12-hour off cycle
- Š Air changes will occur at least 10 times per hour
- Š Temperature is maintained between 64 and 79 degrees F (1&6 degrees C
- Š Relative humidity is maintained between 30% and 70%
- Š Ambient noise is an intrinsic artifact of the facility; a silent facility cannot be guaranteed.

2. Daily Activities

- Š Animal census and health assessments are conducted
- Š Temperature and humidity are monitored in the macroenvironments
- Š Food and water are provided as needed
- Š General sanitation is maintained
- Š Records are updated
- Š Biweekly (twice per week) activities: Š Bedding under hanging wire cages is changed
- Š Trays are sanitized

3. Weekly Activities

- Š Animals are changed to clean polycarbonate bin microenvironments with clean bedding
 - Š Floors are mopped

4. Fortnightly (Every 2 Weeks)

- Š Water bottles are changed out and sanitized
- Š Sinks are cleaned

5. Monthly

- Š Walls of macroenvironments are cleaned
- Š Vents and drains of macroenvironments are cleaned
- Š Hanging cage microenvironments are sanitized
