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2. PURPOSE:

The Academic Council will change philosophy, disapprove, mission and the original intent) of proposals and recommended curricular proposals.

3. MEMBERSHIP:

The Academic Council is composed of the Vice President for Academic Affairs, CVBA, and designated representatives of the General Faculty. Elected and appointed members will serve for three years, one-third elected or appointed each year. Deans, directors, and other guests may participate in all discussion but may not present motions, seconds, or votes.

4. CHAIRPERSON/SECRETARY:

The Chairperson will be chosen by the Academic Council. The Secretary will be chosen by the Academic Council. The Secretary will be responsible for the written draft of

9. PROXIES:

Proxies will identify themselves to the Chairperson and the membership at the meeting. No person may hold more than one proxy. Members sending a proxy to the meeting should notify the Secretary in writing prior to the meeting.

10. AD-HOC COMMITTEES:

The Chairperson may appoint ad-hoc committees as needed.

11. AMENDMENTS TO BYLAWS:

The Academic Committee Bylaws may be changed by two-thirds majority vote of the voting membership. Changes must be published and distributed to the voting membership one month before any action can be taken.
